
On January 9, 2024, the Governor's Office issued a temporary emergency Executive Order to remove barriers for undergraduate Jewish college students seeking to transfer to a Florida college because of a well-founded fear of antisemitic or other religious discrimination, harassment, intimidation, or violence at an out-of-state, degree-granting, accredited institution within the United States. The College shall waive out-of-state fees, where applicable due to a financial hardship, for students who seek to transfer and can demonstrate a well-founded fear of persecution.

Below are guidelines for students and staff.

Student Process:

Application and enrollment guidelines for transfer Jewish college students from out of state accredited colleges or universities:

1. The applicant must complete and submit a readmit () or online transfer student admission application to Broward College and answer the following question in the **Additional Information** section of the application: *"Are you a Jewish college student who recently relocated to Florida because of a well-founded fear of antisemitic or other religious discrimination, harassment, intimidation, or violence at an out-of-state, degree-granting, accredited institution within the United States and face financial hardship?"*
